Remote Learning Offer

Purpose

This policy sets out the school's approach to providing remote education for pupils who are unable to attend school due to exceptional circumstances. It ensures consistency, clarity, and high standards in remote teaching and learning, in line with government guidance.

Scope

- Applies to pupils of compulsory school age
- Applies in situations where attendance is restricted (e.g. school closures), or where an individual pupil is unable to attend in person but is able to learn.
- Applies to all staff involved in remote education: teachers, teaching assistants, senior leaders.

Curriculum

Due to the significant needs of our pupils, each remote education offer will be created to truly support the pupil as well as the family.

Individual equipment, resources, and activities will be provided to each family underpinned by receptive and expressive communication aids as appropriate.

Communication

Each pupil and their family will continue to link in with their key teacher who will adapt and replace resources and equipment as necessary.

Expectation

Progress school understands that in some cases, due to the pupil's difficulty continuing education at home is not appropriate. Each key teacher will continue to be in regular contact with our families offering appropriate support.

Safeguarding and wellbeing

Daily checks on pupil safety and welfare will be carried out by the key teacher or Headteacher where pupils are learning remotely.
